Program Philosophy Statement

The Montezuma County Sheriff's Office has established a scholarship program for 2018. The award amount will be \$1000. This effort is a meaningful expression of the Sheriffs' confidence in and respect for education and training. We consider this an investment in the future and we believe that we are helping to provide deserving students with an opportunity to make a positive contribution to society as a whole.

Eligibility

Any permanent legal resident of Montezuma County who plans to enroll in a vocational training program or institution of higher learning within the state of Colorado as a full- or part-time student for the 2018-19 school year is eligible.

Applicants must be legal residents of the United States and eligible for admission or readmission to the school(s) or institution(s) of learning indicated in the application. The award will only be paid for attendance at certified schools or institutions of learning **within the State of Colorado**.

There shall be no restrictions as to the course of study or training pursued. No restrictions shall be placed by reason of race, creed, color, age, sex or national origin.

We will only consider applicants that apply using the Montezuma County Sheriff's Office Scholarship application format

APPLICATION. Applicants submitting other forms will be disqualified.

Terms

Applicants must maintain good standing in their chosen program.

Applications received by the Montezuma County Sheriff's Office will be reviewed by a citizens committee selected by the Sheriff. The committee will select one scholarship recipient and two runners up.

Announcement of Awards

The final selection process is to be completed in time to allow the award announcement by April 20, 2018. Awards will be presented to recipients by Sheriff Steve Nowlin.
